
Office Order

CRP round is being implemented in 10 resource blocks by SERP, 5 resource blocks by BRLPS and 7 Intensive blocks by Internal CRPs. As the RBs/IBs will be responsible for generating internal CRPs who will then be responsible for expanding the SHG movement in other blocks of Rajasthan, they need special emphasis.

As per previous office order number 7565 – 615 dated 16.05.2014 regarding nomination of Nodal officers, All SPMU officers were directed to visit and monitor allotted blocks on regular basis and report immediately after the visit to State Mission Director (List enclosed). Similarly DPMs/managers of the concerned districts were also directed to adopt one cluster in the RB/IB and closely monitor entire project activities in that particular cluster (A list of nodal officers and the allotted Resource/Intensive blocks is enclosed). It has been observed that the SPMU and DPMU officers are not monitoring/giving emphasis on the Blocks /clusters allotted as desired.


Thus all concerned SPMU officers and DPMs are directed to strictly comply with the directions and ensure stay of atleast 5 days and 4 nights in each fortnight in the village of RB/IB. The nodal officers should ensure that all the activities in their block/cluster are going on as per the strategy. The Concerned Nodal Officer would be solely responsible and accountable for entire work progress of SHG movement in the resource block /cluster allotted. Special emphasis should be given to Active Women (AW) identified and her capacity building/handholding during the visit. The Nodal Officers of resource/intensive blocks should send a back to office report in the prescribed format. Only those Nodal Officers will be considered to have complied with the instructions, who have submitted the back to office report.

GM (RB) should compile a report every fortnight of all nodal officers (SPMs/DPMs/Managers) and put up to higher authorities for review. Non compliance in this regard, will be considered seriously and strict action will be taken against such officers. The DPMs will be responsible for ensuring compliance in their districts.
